

Bulky household waste

Bulky waste or large quantities of waste can be taken to the recycling centre. Bring your ID and bank card with you. Payment can only be made by debit card.

The recycling centre is open Tuesday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. The address is Mijnheerkensweg 31, opposite the paper factory.

Are you unable to take your bulky household waste to the recycling centre yourself? 'Het Goed Roermond' collects usable and unusable items. There is a charge for this service.



Large items that are broken?

Take them to the recycling centre!

Thrift shop

You can take usable items, electrical appliances and textiles to the Het Goed thrift shop free of charge or have them collected.

Glass

You can throw glass in the glass recycling bin.

If the glass does not fit in the glass recycling bin, you can take it to the recycling centre. Do not place glass next to the glass recycling bin. This creates litter on the street and is unsafe for people and animals.



Glass jars and bottles?

Throw them in the glass recycling bin!

Clothing

There are clothing bins at various locations in the municipality where you can drop off your clothing

Scan the QR code to see where they are located. Put your unwanted clothing in a closed bag before placing it in the clothing bin.



Tired of your outfit?

Take it to the clothing bin!



PMD

PMD stands for plastic, metal and drink cartons. Plastic packaging waste, metal (cans) and drink cartons can be separated at home in the transparent plastic bags provided for this purpose.

PMD waste is collected from your home every week. Check www.mijnafvalwijzer.nl for the correct collection day.



Plastic and metal packaging or beverage cartons?

Collect them in the PMD bag!

Waste paper and cardboard

Check www.mijnafvalwijzer.nl for the correct collection days at your address.

Put your waste paper and cardboard in a closed cardboard box and make sure it cannot blow away. This will help keep your neighbourhood clean. The collection day may change during public holidays. Please also check your waste collection calendar for any changes. You can also take your waste paper and cardboard to the Milieupark (address: Mijnheerkensweg 31 in Roermond).



Waste paper?

Put it out on the street on collection day!

Deposit

- event venues
